This intensive, one-day CME cadaver lab focuses on advanced lower extremity surgical techniques, transitioning from soft tissue decompression and recession in the morning to complex reconstructive frames and bone transport in the afternoon.

Morning Session: Soft Tissue and Minimally Invasive Surgical (MIS) Techniques

The morning focuses on functional lengthening, decompression, and minimally invasive surgical (MIS) approaches:

- **Compartment and Nerve Decompression:** Prophylactic anterior compartment fasciotomy (longitudinal/transverse) and tarsal tunnel decompression with plantar fascial release.
- **Muscle/Tendon Lengthening:** Mastery of the Baumann (deep) and Vulpius (superficial) gastrocnemius-soleus recessions.
- **Advanced Flaps:** Harvest and rotation of the medial gastrocnemius flap.
- **MIS Osteotomies:** Guided practice in minimally invasive approaches to the metatarsals, midfoot, and tibia.

Afternoon Session: Specialized Reconstruction

The afternoon transitions into high-level deformity correction and limb salvage, split into three specialized tracks:

- **Group A (Cable Transport):** Led by Dr. Stephen Quinnan; focusing on internal bone transport mechanisms.
- **Group B (Butt Frame):** Led by Dr. Guido LaPorta; focusing on circular external fixation for complex foot and ankle stabilization.
- **Group C (Transverse Tibial Transport):** Focusing on specialized transport techniques for vascularity or segmental defects.

This one-day orthopedic surgical course is designed to provide surgeons, fellows, and residents with a comprehensive understanding of knee osteotomy techniques used for joint preservation and deformity correction. Through a combination of lectures, hands-on sawbone workshops, and cadaveric surgical training, participants will learn the principles and execution of common proximal tibial and distal femoral osteotomies.

The course emphasizes practical surgical skills, deformity analysis, preoperative planning, and intraoperative decision-making, allowing participants to translate concepts directly into clinical practice. Attendees will leave with a clear framework for evaluating limb alignment, selecting appropriate patients, planning osteotomies, and performing these procedures safely and reproducibly.

The disaster response course focuses on providing orthopedic care in the aftermath of local or international disasters. Attendees will learn from surgeons experienced in all phases of domestic and international disaster response, with a focus on disaster response principles and on adapting to resource-limited environments. Surgical procedures will be performed on cadaveric specimens and will include both soft tissue procedures and provisional skeletal stabilization, as well as common amputations, rotational flaps for coverage, and external fixation for reconstruction.
